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From the Assistant Principal

MAI'S:

Over the past two weeks, the teachers have been busily conducting the Maths Assessment Interview with all the students in their class. Thank you to the parents who were able to bring their children in the holidays, or stay back after school in order to complete the MAI. The information gathered from this assessment tool will help the teacher in understanding how your child thinks about mathematics. It enables the teacher to personalise the learning so that maths lessons and tasks are catered for each child's ability. The data is also used by the school and the Catholic Education Office to track students mathematical thinking over time. Students who have not yet completed the MAI will do so in the next week during class time.

Year 1-6 Meet the Teacher Afternoon:

This is organised for next Monday 10 February between 3:30-5:30pm. This is an opportunity for you to meet your child's 2014 teacher and observe the learning spaces. Year 1-6 teachers will be available in their classrooms during this time. You are invited to bring your child to the classroom **at any time** during this two hour period for about 15minutes. During this time your child will be asked to lead you through a tour of the classroom. Your child will also discuss with you a hand out which communicates important information that the classroom teacher would like you to know about the year. It is also an opportunity for you to introduce your self to the teacher. Please note, this is **NOT** a Parent-teacher interview time. Should you require a more detailed time to meet with your classroom teacher to discuss specific learning needs of your child, you will need to make a separate appointment. This will replace our more traditional Parent teacher nights that usually occur at this time. There will be tea and coffee provided by the P&F from 3:00pm at the Multi Purpose Centre.

Sports Equipment:

The school has recently purchased 10 sets of portable soccer goal posts, a portable shade structure and upgraded the portable Basketball rings. This was partly funded by the \$3000 grant given to us from last years Southlands shopper docket promotion. We are also currently awaiting our items that we ordered from the Woolworths shopper docket promotion from last year. We have ordered classroom teaching material and resources for use in Kindergarten to Year 6.

The Prayer Bag is a very special and sacred bag. We know that you, with your child will take care of it and see that it is *completely and safely* returned to school to ensure every child is given the same prayerful opportunity.
