Dear Parents and Friends of St Mary MacKillop School, Our school constantly strives to be:

A Christ centered community which challenges students to develop their unique gifts and talents through a supportive partnership of school, parents and parish.

Our world is moving through troubling and difficult times at the moment with many places around the globe struggling to maintain the peace and safety that we in Australia take as expected each and every day. One of our communities has had these challenges visit them in a very close and dreadful way. I have included a statement from our Executive Director of Schools, Mr Greg Whitby regarding this challenging time for our brothers and sisters in the diocese.

The community of St Bernadette's Catholic Primary Lalor Park is in mourning with the confirmation that 7-year-old Julian Cadman, a student of St Bernadette's, lost his life in the attack in Barcelona last Thursday evening. Julian was a delightful little boy - curious and energetic with a kind and generous heart. He was much loved by his teachers and fellow students. The school community is feeling his loss deeply. Together with the St Bernadette's community, we pray for Julian's family, particularly his mother Jumarie who was seriously injured in the attack, his father Andrew, and for all those affected by this terrible event. The Diocese of Parramatta stands ready to provide the family and the St Bernadette's community with any assistance needed. Counsellors will be at the school this week, and for as long as they are needed, to support students and staff. The Cadman family have requested privacy at this incredibly difficult time and we encourage everyone to honour this request. Julian, you will be in our hearts always.

I ask that you keep this family in your prayers at this time as well as those in the St Bernadette's community as they struggle to make sense of this desperate tragedy.

Getting safely to school

I also want to take the time to acknowledge and thank Tony who looks after our school crossing every morning and every afternoon. His commitment and dedication to the safety and care of our children is exemplary. It is a comfort to know that he is looking after our children to ensure that they get across the road safely.

Could I ask that we all support him in his work by doing our bit to help get all children safely to school and home again. Please do not park in the areas around the crossing as this structs the vision of the cars and of Tony. Please avoid using the school driveway to drop children off as this congests the crossing when you reverse back out again. Most importantly, when you see Tony please remember to say 'Thank you' as he really has the best interests of your child and ours at heart.
