Thank you to the parents who have brought their children to school out of school hours to sit the MAI. This data serves as a valuable teaching tool to enable targeted, personalised learning for every student.

EARLY YEARS ASSESSMENT (EYA)

In a few weeks our students in Kindergarten, Year One and Year Two will participate in an Observation Survey of Early Literacy. These assessment inform the teachers and enables them to plan the teaching and learning experiences for our Infants classes. The assessments also help the school to identify vulnerable students for targeted intervention programs.

SPORT DAYS IN 2019

This year Mrs Margo Woodhead will be joining the staff of St Mary MacKillop as our sport teacher. Sport will be held on the following days

Monday: Year 5, Year 6 and 3T Tuesday: Year 2, Year 4 and 3H

Wednesday: Year 1 and Kindergarten.

Students are required to wear their sports uniform including their school hat. They and are encouraged to bring their drink bottle with them. In the event of wet/sweat weather, lessons will take place in the school hall.

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BUILDING CHILD SAFE COMMUNITIES - FORMS FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS

'Building Child Safe Communities' is an initiative developed by Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta that enhances our commitment to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all students in our care. It is now a requirement that all volunteers complete an online undertaking form that confirms expectations in relation to behaviour whilst volunteering or contracting at schools. This undertaking form also seeks to determine the suitability of volunteers and contractors by requiring them to declare that they do not have a criminal history involving children.

Volunteers – please access the form via the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta public webpage http://www.parra.catholic.edu.au, then click on 'Child Protection Training Forms' (halfway down page on the right hand side).

Then click on 'Volunteer Form' (halfway down page).

You will receive a confirmation email once the form has been submitted. Your details are maintained confidentiality in a central database and a copy of your confirmation is emailed to the location where you are volunteering.

So if you would like to be a parent helper at sports carnivals, reading groups, gala days, excursions etc you will need to complete the form.
