Dear Parents and Carers,



I have just finished a walk through our classrooms to help me learn about the great things happening at our school. I do this every day and often take other school leaders with me to share our thoughts. I am amazed with how quickly our children and teachers have been able to transition back into the learning.

Our areas for improvement this year are:

For all students to demonstrate the connection between 'scripture (biblical texts), Catholic teaching (catechism), practices or tradition (what we do) AND the modern world in the R.E curriculum.

# For all students to demonstrate 12 months growth in literacy and numeracy for a year at school.

Today I was able to spend some time with our teachers from Grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 as they worked in teams to develop 'Learning Cycles' for their students using the new Religious Education Curriculum for our diocese. These Learning Cycles will be implemented next Term and have been designed with our first improvement goal in mind. We are teaching our faith and Catholic traditions very differently through this new curriculum and the teachers have been doing 'big learning' themselves.

I have also noticed on my walks that the challenge in what students are being asked to learn in Mathematics is really high. In Year Six I worked with students who were learning how to find the area of circles and how Pi (as a formula) is integral in measuring this. Kindergarten had exceeded their outcomes for measuring mass when I came through. They were using balance pans and recording their discoveries around heavy and light. (This is usually learning for Year 1). In Year 1 the children were learning to record their multiplication learning as 'arrays' and even 'partial arrays'.

This challenging learning would normally commence in Year 2. There are examples all across the school where children, at all stages of the learning journey, are being challenges to do hard thinking and grow in their understanding. We want all of our students to grow in Maths this year.

I look forward to one day being able to connect the great tools we used during remote learning with the great learning happening in our classrooms so that you can share in the awesome things happening at St Mary MacKillop. Rest assured that we are back being Safe Respectful Learners.

We are giving our parents the opportunity to share your thoughts with teachers by recording them on the attached sheet or you can book in a conversation with the teachers over zoom.

## Learning Conversations will commence week 9 Monday 22 June 2020. Teachers have selected various times and days of Week 9 and 10.

We will be using our online booking system for the Parent/Teacher conversations via www.schoolinterviews.com.au website.

- Enter the Event Code 'e6rpj' in the white box then select 'GO'
- Enter your email address (used to confirm your appointment)
- Enter Parents Full Name
- Enter contact phone number
- Select number of students for interviews
- Enter Students Christian and Surname
- Select GO
- Select the teachers you wish to see for each child
- Select GO
- Select the appointment time that suits you best for each child
- The system will not allow 'Back to Back' appointments, so you will need to allow time in between each interview for each child. Unavailable times will be marked with a 'red cross'.
- When you click FINISH, your interview timetable will be emailed to you automatically. PLEASE KEEP THIS EMAIL SOMEWHERE SAFE. You will need to return to this email on the day of your appointment. 3 minutes before your appointment time, click on the ZOOM LINK (next to the teacher's name) and follow onscreen instructions
- You can return to <u>www.schoolinterviews.com.au</u> at any time and change your interviews until the bookings close on Friday 19 June at 4:00pm. Remember to use the same name and email address you used when you made your original booking/s.
- Parents wishing to change their interview times after the closing date should contact the school directly on 02 4724 3200
- For parents that do not have internet access, or if you are having trouble with the site, please contact the school office on 02 4724 3200 for assistance.
- Conversations are strictly 10 minutes only. To allow for technical issues it is vital that parents keep to this schedule and end their appointment in a timely manner.
