Change to naming for Class Groups in 2022

You will notice with the staffing for next year, every class is identified by the grade and either a letter G or a letter M (e.g. 1G and 1M). The 'G' represents our school colours – Green and Gold, whilst the 'M' represents our patron saint – Mary MacKillop. We have been asked to make this change by our diocesan office. The reasoning for the change is explained below:

"In 2021, one of the major issues faced by some Primary schools was around the naming convention used for grade classes and the downstream impact on other systems such as Compass Reports, Scheduling and PTA.

Our school currently names grade classes using the initials of the teachers such as: 6S for Mrs Smith's class. The limitation of this convention is, if and when a teacher changes during the year, then the class name must also be changed. The time between when a teacher changes and when the class is renamed (by the Compass team) has caused some concern for schools.

The below proposed naming convention removes the need for this renaming process.

Approximately 80% of CEDP primary schools use generic form group names based on colours such as: KB (Kinder Blue), 1G (1 Gold) etc.

In 2022, we request all Primary schools to adopt this naming convention to ensure schools can avoid the challenges associated with current practices."

School Crossing Supervisor

You may have noticed recently that our pedestrian crossing is not always attended before school or after school. Since our last KIT, I have contacted the 'Centre for Road Safety – Transport for NSW' who provide us with this service. I clarified with them the issue and challenges that this creates for our community.

They were very understanding and explained to me that they have had a significant number of medical retirements in their team following this year's COVID lockdown. Whilst they have been endeavouring to use their casual / relief staff to support our community, they have a huge demand across their service currently. Transport for NSW is presently recruiting staff and the process concludes next Friday. This should allow them to employ replacement staff for their team and provision a better and more reliable service for us in the future.

Leaving Families

A term's notice (10 school weeks) in writing must be given to the Principal before the removal of a student or a full term's fees will be payable. The notice can be given any time during term for the next term. Where appropriate notice has been received a pro-rata credit can be calculated based on a pro-rata 40 week year. One exception is that notice in writing will be accepted at any time during Term 4 in relation to the following years' enrolment i.e. the notice period of 10 school weeks will be waived in this circumstance. If you know your child (<u>Kindergarten-Year 5</u>) will be leaving at the end of the year, please advise the school as soon as possible.
