### First Week of 2023!



























Dear St Mary MacKillop Families,



I hope you all had a wonderful holiday with your family and a great start to the year. All the teachers are looking forward to a great year of learning with your children and are looking forward to seeing you at the Welcome BBQ next week.

As we begin the 2023 school year there are just a few friendly reminders about attendance and learning and safety in the afternoons.

### <u>Attendance</u>

Please send your child/children to school on time each day. Regular attendance at school is essential for a smooth start to the day and academic progress. Students should be within the school grounds by **8:42am** in preparation for the commencement of the school day:

Monday to Friday **8:42am** (First Bell – Warning) **8:45am** (Second Bell – Commencement of Class)

The school gate is locked at 8:45am and any students arriving after 8:45am need to be taken to the office by a parent who is required to sign them in and obtain a late note.

### <u>Afternoon Dismissal</u>

To allow a quick, orderly and safe dismissal of an afternoon we ask that *all parents who are collecting their children at 3pm please wait in the park across the road and not at the front gate.* 

The front gate needs to be kept clear for all students exiting the grounds and to load children on to buses.

**If you are collecting your child from waiters this can be done at 3:10pm** – again to keep the front gate clear free from obstructions for the children catching buses home. Children on waiters sit behind the bus lines on the school playground.

### **Leaving Students**

A term's notice (10 school weeks) in writing must be given to the Principal before the removal of a student or a full term's fees will be payable. The notice can be given any time during term for the next term. Where appropriate notice has been received a pro-rata credit can be calculated based on a pro-rata 40 week year. One exception is that notice in writing will be accepted at any time during Term 4 in relation to the following years' enrolment i.e. the notice period of 10 school weeks will be waived in this circumstance. If you know your child will be leaving at the end of the year, please advise the school as soon as possible.

### **Regular Attendance And Absences**

Please send your child on time each day. Regular attendance at school is essential for progress. If your child is unavoidably late, a *parent must take them to the office* for a late note. If your child is going to be away from school for more than two days please contact the school office. A note is required explaining all absences. It is necessary to notify the Principal by letter if a child has to miss school for any length of time e.g. holidays, transfers, sickness. If a child is absent for one day please send a note to the child's teacher on the child's return or submit an absent note through the Compass Parent Portal.

There are new Government guidelines for schools to follow when marking the school rolls. These guidelines require parents who are taking their children on holidays, during the school year, to complete a request of 'Exemption from School Attendance' form. These forms are to be completed prior to your holiday. If you are taking your child on leave for more than 5 days a copy of your travel itinerary is required with the application. The school principal can only approve up to 50 school days leave. Longer periods require the approval of the Director of Schools and the Catholic Education Commission.

To be eligible for Confirmation, children must be in Year 5 or above and must be baptised, have received 1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion.


